



**Ancient Wonders:  
Exploring Cusco, Sacred Valley of the Incas  
and Machu Picchu**

**CUSCO – SACRED VALLEY – MACHU PICCHU**

(4 Days / 3 Nights)

## FEBRUARY – MARCH 2027

### DAY 1 LIMA – CUSCO

Meals included: None

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Cusco.

Be amazed by the culture, Inca architecture, and traditions of this impressive city. Upon arrival in the "Imperial City," you will be met by our guide and transferred to your selected hotel in Cusco.

### DAY 2 CUSCO – SACRED VALLEY

Meals included: Breakfast and Lunch

We will depart for the Sacred Valley. Along the way, we will stop in Chinchero to join a local family of weavers in their courtyard for an overview of the Andean weaving process. Chinchero is renowned for its production of textiles made on backstrap looms. You will see how the wool is carded, spun, and dyed, and learn about the different techniques used to create belts, *ponchos*, and shawls.

We will continue to the Maras salt mines, where an intense white shines like snow on a sunny day, offering a breathtaking panorama. Since the time of the Inca Empire, salt has been extracted using the same artisanal methods.

Finally, we will visit Moray. We will appreciate the complex of circular terraces hidden among the hills. Similar in appearance to Greek amphitheaters, Moray is framed by imposing snow-capped mountains and was used as an agricultural laboratory to adapt seeds to different microclimates.

### DAY 3 SACRED VALLEY – MACHU PICCHU – CUSCO

Meals included: Breakfast and Lunch

At a designated time, you will be transferred from your hotel to the Ollantaytambo train station to board the train. This 1.5-hour journey takes us through the Sacred Valley of the Incas to the town of Aguas Calientes.



Upon arrival in the town of Aguas Calientes, a bus will take us to the entrance of Machu Picchu. Centuries passed before the citadel was discovered by the Spanish until Hiram Bingham brought it to the world's attention in 1911. During a guided tour, we will appreciate its topography and the ingenuity employed in its construction, which makes this Inca city one of the New Seven Wonders of the World.

In the afternoon, we will return by train from Aguas Calientes to Ollantaytambo. You will be picked up and transferred to your hotel in Cusco.

#### **DAY 4 CUSCO – LIMA**

Meals included: Breakfast

The morning guided tour includes the Temple of the Sun or Koricancha, the Cathedral, as well as the Sacsayhuaman Fortress, one of the most remarkable Inca buildings, the Kenko amphitheater, the red fortress of Puca Pucara and the Tambomachay fountains whose aqueducts continue to provide crystal clear water to the site.

At the appropriate time, you will be transferred to the airport to take your return flight to Lima and connect with your international flight.
