



A JOURNEY BETWEEN DISTILLED SPIRITS AND GEOGLYPHS

Lima – Paracas – Lima
(2 Days / 1 Night)

FEBRUARY – MARCH 2027

DAY 1 LIMA – ICA - PARACAS

Meals included: Lunch

At the agreed-upon time, we will begin our private trip from Lima to Paracas (with a Spanish-speaking driver only).

After a 5-hour drive, we will arrive in Ica, where we will have the opportunity to visit the Huacachina oasis, 5 km from Ica, surrounded by giant sand dunes, palm trees, and other vegetation.

We will whet our appetites with a tour of the oldest operating distillery in the Americas. After experiencing 336 years of tradition, we will move to the current production facility for a tasting of 5 of the most awarded piscos, followed by a traditional lunch.

Then, we will return to Paracas, where you will have the rest of the day free to enjoy your hotel.

DAY 2 PARACAS – LIMA

Meals included: Breakfast

In the morning, we head to the pier to visit the Ballestas Islands aboard a comfortable motorboat. Here, we'll enjoy close-up views of dozens of sea lions swimming near the boat or basking on the shore, as well as various species of seabirds, including the guanay cormorant, Peruvian pelicans, and, with luck, even one of the famous Humboldt penguins (no opportunity to disembark).

Flight over the Nazca Lines aboard a modern airplane.

You'll be able to photograph the most famous figures, including the condor, the hummingbird, the astronaut, and many more. These figures are fully visible only from the air, which has given rise to various theories about their origin. The flight lasts approximately 1.5 hours.

In the afternoon, we will return to your hotel in Lima (only with a Spanish-speaking driver).
